Aerospace Manufacturing Training Program

The Aerospace Manufacturing Training Program (AMTP) provides classroom and hands-on, shop floor training for aerospace assemblers.

During the training program, students will learn the basics, including:

- Safety
- Precision Measurements
- Drilling/Reaming/Countersinking
- Reading Engineering Drawings
- Electrical Bonding
- Composites

Upon successful completion each student will receive:

- **AMTP Certificate of completion**
- **Manufacturing Skills Standards Council (MSSC) certification**
- **National Center for Aircraft Technician Training (NCATT) certification**



Each applicant must:

- **Be at least 18 years old**
- **Have a high school diploma or GED**
- **Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien**
- **Have NO felony convictions**
- **Be able to pass a background check and drug screen test**
- **Demonstrate successful performance on nationally accepted aptitude test**
- **Males 18-25 years of age must be registered for Selective Service**
